



A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL TO APPROVE THE SUBMISSION OF THE NATIONAL COMMUNITY WILDLIFE HABITAT APPLICATION TO THE NATIONAL WILDLIFE FEDERATION




