Important: This collection is restricted to Alpharetta City residents who have pre-registered. (Please note that an Alpharetta mailing address does not verify that your home is within the City limits.)

What is household hazardous waste?

Many chemicals are used every day in our homes and yards. When they are no longer needed or useful, they become waste. These items could be potentially dangerous and are not safe to be disposed in the regular trash due to possible harm to sanitation workers and the environment. Whether you have old pesticides you don't trust, gasoline that isn't usable, items containing mercury or paint products no longer needed, this is your chance to dispose of them.

There is no charge for acceptable materials.

What do you have to do?

-  Submit completed form on or before Thursday, November 11th online (Alpharetta.ga.us, to tporter@alpharetta.ga.us, or fax to (678) 297-6201. You will receive a confirmation.
-  Bring the confirmation with you on November 13th. **Help a neighbor!** If you bring HHW items for your neighbors, remember to bring their confirmation.
-  Bring items safely in original containers and tighten all lids. Do not allow items to mix. No smoking around HHWs when transporting or within the collection site.
-  Remain in your vehicle at the collection.
-  Wear a face covering.
