A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALPHARETTA, GEORGIA TO ADOPT THE MAJOR UPDATE TO THE NORTH POINT ACTIVITY CENTER LCI AND INCORPORATE THE LCI INTO THE 2035 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the North Point Activity Center Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) was adopted by City Council in 2008, and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Regional Commission requires LCI major updates every 10-15 years in order to remain eligible for LCI grant funding, and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded \$100,000.00 in grant funding by the Atlanta Regional Commission in 2017 to complete a supplemental study/major update to the North Point Activity Center LCI, and

WHEREAS, the City Council awarded the North Point Activity Center LCI major update to Kimley-Horn & Associates, and

WHEREAS, Kimley-Horn & Associates in conjunction the City Staff led the planning process for the major update to the North Point Activity Center LCI, which included implementation of a public participation plan, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Alpharetta hereby adopts the major update to the North Point Activity Center LCI, attached as Exhibit A, and incorporates the LCI into the 2035 Comprehensive Plan.
