

CITY OF ALPHARETTA POOL RULES

MAIN POOL RULES (POSTED)

1. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
2. No animals other than service animals are permitted.
3. Shower and rinse thoroughly before entering the pool.
4. Solo bathing is not permitted.
5. Bathers with open wounds, skin conditions, or any communicable conditions are not permitted.
6. Swim suits and/or appropriate attire must be worn at all times.
7. Masks, fins, or snorkels are not permitted in pool area.
8. Only Coast Guard approved flotation devices are permitted in pool.
9. Food and beverages permitted in designated areas only.
10. Glass, sharp objects or hazardous materials are not permitted.
11. Skateboards, roller blades bicycles, and/or scooters are not permitted on pool deck.
12. Soap, shampoos, conditioners, body lotions, or body washes are not permitted in pool.
13. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, or otherwise introducing contaminants into the pool is not permitted.
14. Swim diapers required for all infants and children not toilet trained.
15. Running, roughhousing and violent play is prohibited.
16. Maximum bather load is 325 swimmers.
17. Hours of operation: Monday 1pm-6pm (residents and pass holders only); Tuesday-Friday 12pm-5pm and 7:30pm-9pm; Saturday 10am-8pm; Sunday 12pm-8pm. (Pool may close early without notice for maintenance, weather, swim meets, special events, etc. Holiday hours may vary. Contact Alpharetta Recreation and Parks at 678-297-6100 for hours of operation on any given day.)
18. Pool Manager/Lifeguard has final authority on all rules and regulations.

SPLASH ZONE RULES (POSTED)

1. Clean footwear or aqua socks are strongly recommended.
2. Misuse and/or abuse of the splash pad equipment (i.e. climbing, hanging, swinging, or pulling on equipment) is not allowed.
3. Athletic equipment, balls, bats, beach balls, noodles, etc. are not allowed.
4. Objects such as chairs, strollers, etc. are not allowed in the splash pad area.
5. Running, roughhousing and violent play is prohibited.
6. Splash pad may be closed (without notice) at any time due to weather, maintenance, scheduled programs or other operational concerns.

Alpharetta Recreation and Parks Department reserves the right to remove a participant/spectator from the pool and/or splash pad for violating any of the above rules or engaging in illegal, disruptive, destructive, or inappropriate behavior.
